

How to Safely Dispose of Medications



TAKE-BACK SITE

The U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration says the best way to get rid of drugs you don't need any more is at a drug take-back location.

Many pharmacies offer this service, but be sure to call your local one to be sure.

FIND A LOCATION



DISPOSE

If you can't take your drugs to a take-back event, follow these steps:

- Remove the drugs from the original container and mix with something like used coffee grounds, dirt or cat litter.
- ☐ Put the mixture in something you can close to keep it from spilling.
- Scratch out all your personal information on the empty packaging to protect your identity. Then, throw it away.

MORE TIPS



FLUSH

If you can't get rid of your medication another way, check to see if it's safe to flush it.

CHECK THE LIST



Talk with your pharmacist if you have any questions about safely throwing away your medicine.
